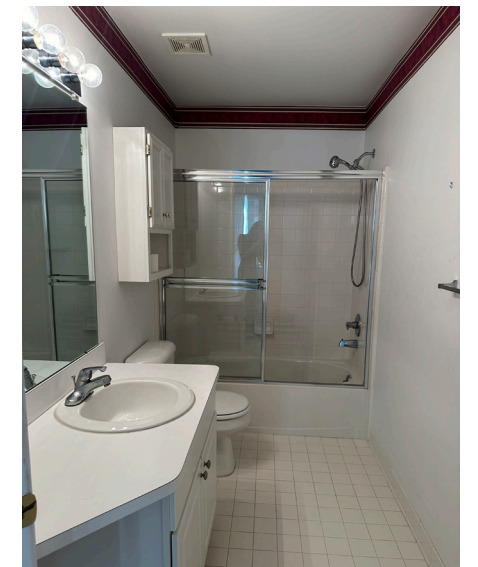
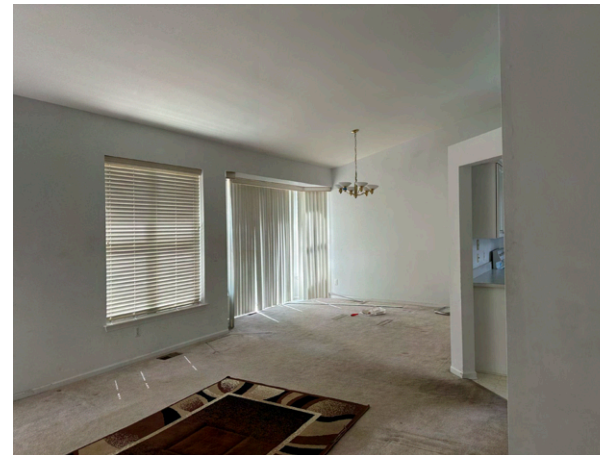
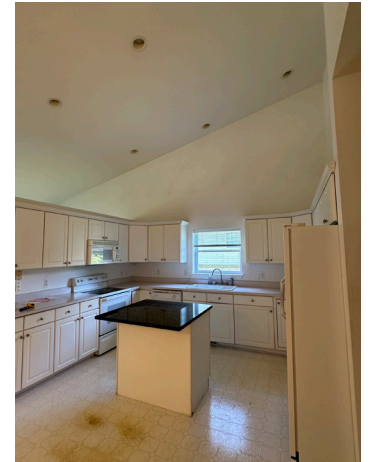


# 01. ranch renovation

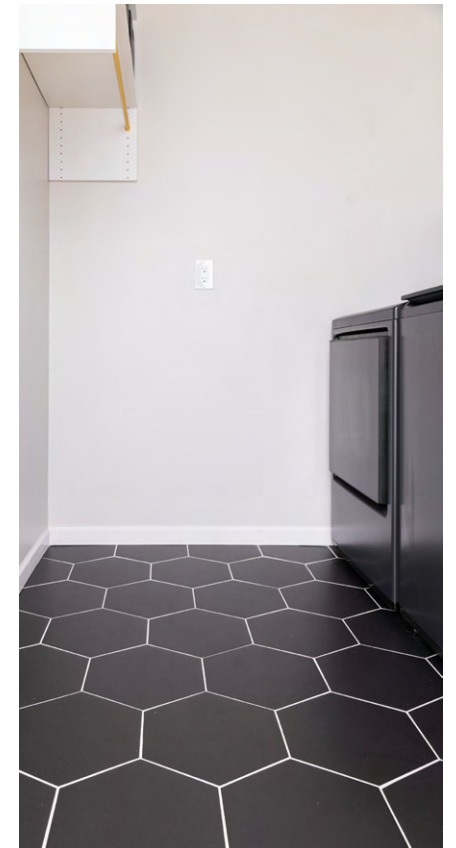
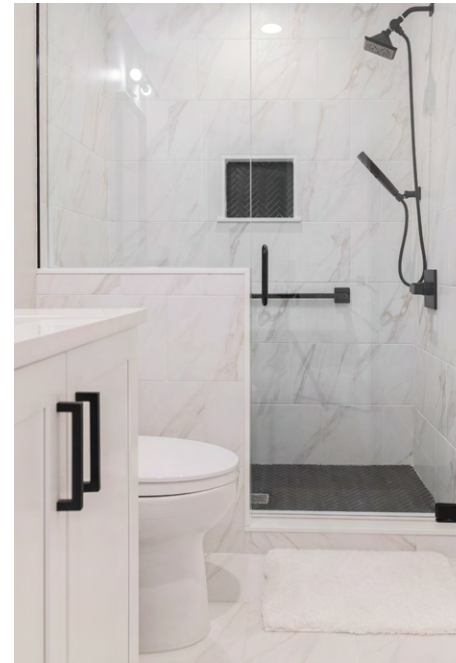

Robotic Muscle Therapy uses a therapeutic robot to administer gentle pressure, in intervals to a specific muscle. I worked as the lead designer on this job and have completed everything from schematic conceptualization to rendering and specifying all necessary materials and furniture. Working closely with the construction documents, I received the floor plan and brought the client's vision to life through detailed renderings and specifications.

Providing a detailed set of renderings prior to starting the build out was very crucial to ensure that the client and designer were on the same page before purchasing any materials or furniture. This helped the client get a very accurate idea of what the space will look like once it is built out.

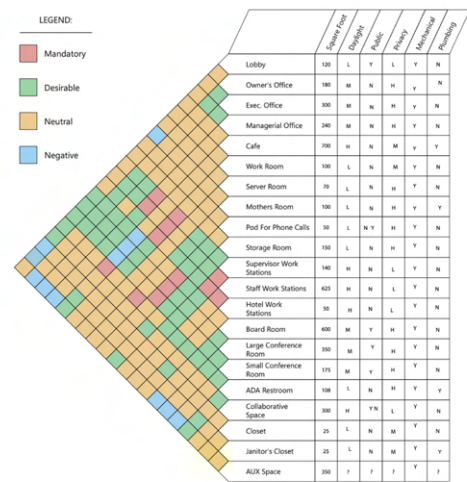




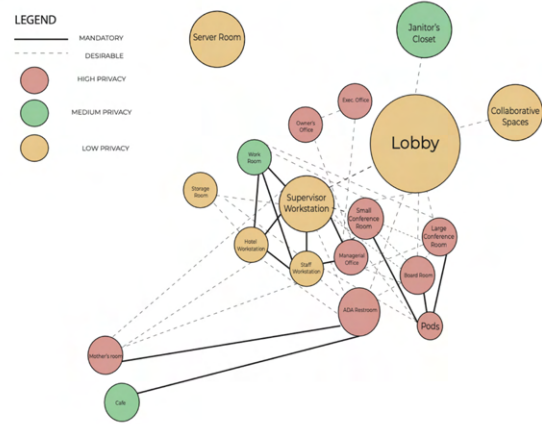

The Martin Agency is a family-owned insurance agency that recently relocated with the goal of redesigning their space to attract new talent.



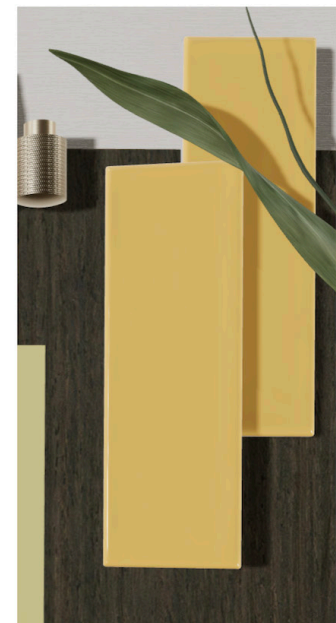

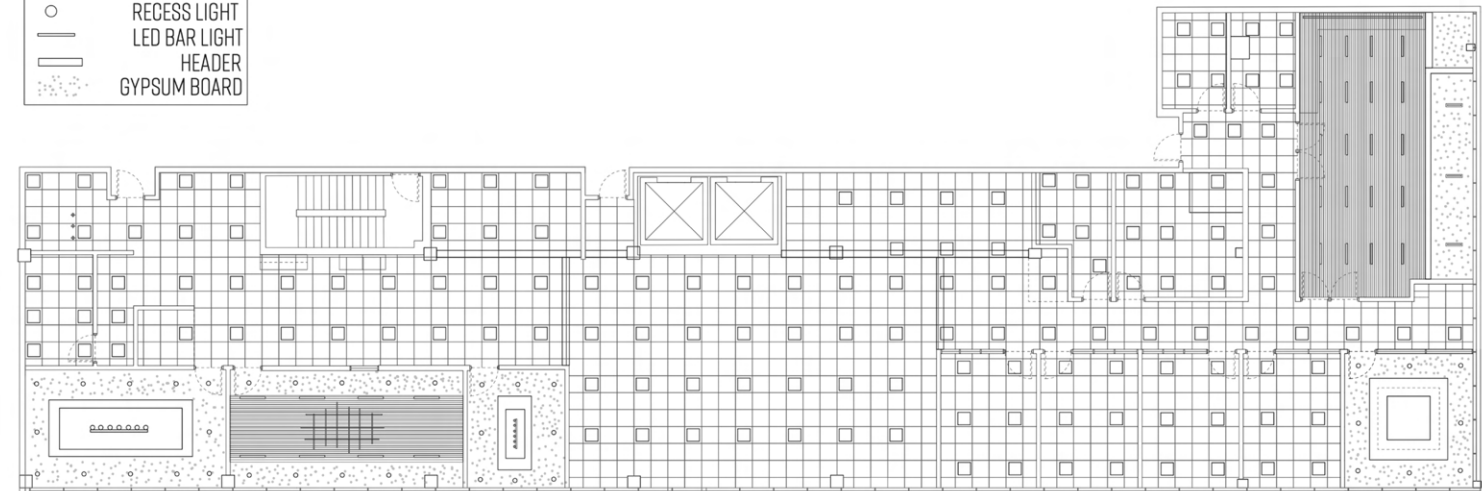
